Mr. Clayton (Clay) M. Jones was appointed chairman, president and chief executive officer (CEO) of Rockwell Collins in June 2002. He had been president and CEO of Rockwell Collins since 2001.

Prior to his position as CEO, Mr. Jones served as president of Rockwell Collins and was a corporate officer and a senior vice president of Rockwell International, positions to which he was appointed in 1998. Prior to that, he held positions as vice president and general manager of Rockwell Collins Air Transport division and as corporate senior vice president of Government Operations and International divisions.



From 1988 to 1995, Mr. Jones was responsible for the space and aircraft systems businesses as vice president of aerospace Government affairs and marketing. In 1982, Rockwell Collins sponsored Mr. Jones to serve as a fellow in a White House Executive Exchange program. Prior to joining Rockwell Collins in 1979, he served in the U.S. Air Force as a fighter pilot.

Mr. Jones serves on the board of governors of the Aerospace Industries Association, the board of directors of the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum, the Tippie College of Business Board of Visitors at the University of Iowa, and the board of trustees for the United Way of East Central Iowa. In addition, he is a member of the Business Roundtable, The Business Council, Iowa Business Council, and the Governor's Iowa Partnership for Economic Progress board.

Mr. Jones is an Honorary Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics and is a director of Deere & Company.

Mr. Jones holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Tennessee and a master's degree in business administration from The George Washington University.
